

POLICY STATEMENT

All Hallows is committed to ensuring the safety of employees, volunteers, members of the congregation, visitors and subcontractors, or anyone affected by our activities as far as is reasonably practicable. As such it is the intention of the church to ensure that;

- (a) We provide a safe working environment using safe equipment and safe methods of working that eliminate hazards where reasonably practicable, or reduce the risk to the lowest possible level—as is reasonably practicable.
- (b) The provision and maintenance of equipment and systems of work (where appropriate) that are safe and without risks to health.
- (c) Arrangements for use, handling storage and transport of articles and substances for use are safe and without risks to health.
- (d) Adequate information is available with respect to articles and substances used detailing the conditions and precautions necessary to ensure that when properly used, they will be safe and without risk to health.
- (e) The provision of information, training and supervision is available as necessary to secure the health and safety of all employees, volunteers and visitors.
- (f) With regard to any premises under the church's control or operations on which employees or volunteers are working, the maintenance of all installations and/or machinery to ensure safety is not only for employees and volunteers, but to any person who may be affected.
- (g) The working environment is safe and without risks to health and that adequate provisions are made with regard to the facilities and arrangements for employee welfare at work.
- (h) This Health & Safety Policy is reviewed annually (at a minimum). Communication of any changes is made to all employees, volunteers and other interested parties.
